GOSSIP COLUMN saved ground until the five-sixteenths pole, got eased outward at that station, kept gradually fanning wider and wider completing the run around the bend, arrived at the quarter pole being lightly hand urged, was given his cue and got angled sharply sharply into the five path a sixteenth later, settled into his best stride after finishing the maneuver, encountered a cluster of rivals in the late stages and went by them all in the shadow of the wire to prove best. UNCLE MITCHO within range from off the inside, swung four wide into the lane, came home with good energy to procure the place. SOUL HOUSE vied for command from the inside feeling the presence of another pair for much of the way to the end of the bend, got set down for the stretch, relinquished reluctantly in the final seventy yards. IRON POWER pressed the issue three wide and held on well to the finish line en route to earning the last major check. MAKE A DECISION three wide departing the backstretch, got asked for a response coming to the five-sixteenths pole, flattened out. DARK ROAST contently tracked the front runners from the pocket, got eased into the two path shortly before reaching the quarter pole, was set down for the drive

home and lacked the needed response. NORTHERN TRIPP inside early, spun six wide, the widest of all, into upper stretch, rallied only mildly. DEFERRED ASSET four wide on the turn, tired. SLIMSHADY raced along the outside and was outrun. SKY COLORS off the rail, was never involved. WISE GUIDE chased two wide and gave way. GREELEY PACK urged in the two path while contesting the pace, gave way after a half.
