### Footnotes

MEDEA (IRE) settled into the middle of the pack, stalked the front runners from the two path under a firm hold until midway on the second bend, tipped slightly wider then rushed up with a menacing run approaching the five-sixteenths pole to take over shortly afterwards, achieving all basically using her own power, was almost at the three-sixteenths pole before getting switched over to some encouragement, fended off the runner up to hold sway. PLEASANT CAT strung out three wide on the opening bend, got hung out in the overland route on the subsequent one, responded well when set down for the drive, drifted out several paths while rallying willingly in midstretch, failed to cut any more into the winner's margin, but continued on with good courage to secure second. CLOTURE, off the inside throughout, raced three to four wide on the far turn, swung about as wide into the stretch, stayed in prominence before flattening out in the late stages. ACQUISITION well reserved two wide during the opening stages, tipped into the three path by the halfway point on the far turn, lacked the needed response. HUMMINGBIRD HILL saved ground and was no factor. WEAWE along the inside, sat wedged between rivals after squeezing his way into the two path at the three-eighths pole, turned for home and had no solid offering. TOY LAND rated in the two path while contesting the lead, took over and tucked along the rail coming to top of the second bend, proved no match when challenged by the winner during the later stages of the run around the far turn and backed away. JEWEL KAT in the three path on the opening bend, continued to stalk the front runner but closer to the rail on the next one, folded. SWEET POTATO vied for the lead from the inside to end of the backstretch and faltered.
