INNER TURF FOR FILLIES THREE YEAR OLDS. No nomination fee. \$5,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$10,000 in addition to the entry fee can be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$2,500 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 on the turf or a Grade 2 twice on the turf since May 1 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade 2 on the turf, 4 lbs.; a Graded Sweepstakes on the turf, 6 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, August 31, 2013 with 37 Nominations.

Footnotes

ALTERITE (FR) sat patiently handled while forwardly placed from off the inside for the opening three-quarters, picked up interest when asked to approaching the quarter pole, was already being roused spinning three wide into the stretch, to the outside and just slightly behind the front runners, maintained the momentum after getting settled into upper stretch, arrived at the furlong marker on nearly even terms with the runner up, drove past that rival soon afterwards and edged away, kept busy. DISCREET MARQ put to a firm hold leaving the starting gate, broke on top and maintained the advantage, rated kindly lulling the field through a series of soft to moderate splits for the initial six furlongs, picked up the tempo upon departing the backstretch, got set down for the stretch, clung to the narrowest of leads with an eighth left, was soon overhauled by the winner but dug in well enough long enough to preserve the place. CONCISE (GB) settled into the pocket after the start, contently kept watch on the pacesetter, briefly waited before tipping into the two path at the top of the lane, finished willingly for the show. WATSDACHANCES (IRE) darted over to the rail after the start, vacated the premises coming to the half mile pole, was three wide a furlong later, continued getting taken outward until about five wide for the commencement of the stretch, was straightened away and came home with good energy to grab the final major slice of the pot. SUMMER OF FUN patiently stalked the pacesetter from the outside for the opening six furlongs, was given her cue and challenged for command from between rivals from the quarter pole to the sixteenth marker before backing away.

PRECARIOUS strung out three wide on the opening bend, remained at a considerable distance from off the inside, swung four wide into the stretch, lacked a solid offering. CAROLINE THOMAS worked out a tuck into the two path shortly after entering the first turn, sat reserved from off the rail, swung five wide into the lane, made no headway. EMOLLIENT saved ground on the first turn, got taken outward entering the backstretch, raced from between foes in the two path for much of the going on the second bend, was slightly wider at the top of the lane, tired. WITH SUGAR ON TOP saved ground during the initial stages, fanned outward to be four wide coming to the three-sixteenths pole, had no response. PRAIA three wide at the crest of the far turn, was about six wide exiting it, got outrun.
