WHYWHYWHY raced close up early, rallied wide on the turn, took over and drew clear entering the stretch then dug in and held PRETTY WILD safe under a drive. PRETTY WILD raced in hand outside early on, advanced four wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely outside. TRUCKLE FEATURE was hustled to the front, set the pace and tired in the stretch. VALID VIDEO ducked in at the start, bumping ATFIRST BLUSH, then was hustled up between rivals, chased the pace and tired after the opening three quarters. ATFIRST BLUSH was bumped at the start, was steadied after the start, dropped back early, raced inside and had no rally. SILVER SQUIRE stumbled at the start, was outrun early, raced wide throughout and tired. BLAKELOCK chased the pace along the inside and tired on the turn.
