Footnotes

FOURTH CHAPTER was put on reserve while racing in the two path, continued to bide her time upon reaching the far turn, lacked optimal racing clearance approaching the quarter pole, being in the middle of a tightly compact field, found room to maneuver into the three path at the head of the stretch, responded well once given her cue, forged to the front at the eighth pole then drew clear under strong handling. BLUE HILL BAY patiently stalked the leader from the outside for nearly three-quarters, was asked for a response soon after settling into the lane, grabbed a narrow lead coming to the eighth pole, relinquished it a couple of jumps later, but continued on willingly enough to outfinish MUSTANG FEVER for the place. MUSTANG FEVER took the inside route, was inching her way into contention departing the half mile pole when steadied in a bit at the seven-sixteenths pole, continued along the inside, remaining on hold, cut the corner, gaining readily on several rivals who chose a wider route into the stretch, angled outward midstretch to continue her bid, but made no significant progress thereafter. BELLA ATTRICE reserved within range three wide around both turns, lacked the necessary stretch response. OPERA HEROINE was taken hold early leaving the gate, stalked along the outside, unasked, swung into the three path around the second turn, continued the chase and gave way after going three-quarters. A WORD TO THE WISE took command soon after the start, was rated on the lead towards the inside and gave way by upper stretch. TALENTED PRINCESS under a firm hold along the outside, angled four wide at the three-eighths pole, but had no kick. SEEING CLEARLY off the inside, trailed.
