Footnotes

FLYING TRAIN broke inward at the start, was lightly coaxed into a forward position before being placed in hand, tracked the leader from the inside, advanced into contention leaving the backstretch, was guided over into the three path coming to the three-eighths pole, cruised by the leader, entirely under her power, was set down after entering the stretch, then drew off from the competition under a vigorous hand ride. HEY VALENTINA was pulled off of CABERNET LADY after brushing that foe at the start, went on to take early command, sped off while placed under a snug hold, had the lead dwindle down soon after entering the turn, offered no resistance when the top one drew alongside, but held well enough during the stretch run to secure the place. SHADY ROAD saved ground throughout and was along for the show. IN HER HEY DAY chased along the outside, and tired. MINE SEARCH off the rail, was urged on the turn and folded. KISSES FROM KAREN raced three wide and gave way. CABERNET LADY asked for some run leaving the starting gate, was nonetheless outsprinted, failed to reach a contending position at any time. RACHAEL'S STING displayed brief foot, began to bear out on the turn, resisting right handed pressure being applied by the rider, then was taken in hand from the quarter pole to the finish line.
