ROMANS REWARD patiently tracked the front runners along the inside before taken out to the three path near the three-eighths pole, advanced forward to issue a challenge shortly before reaching the quarter pole, took charge during the ensuing furlong, drew off a comfortable advantage with a sixteenth to go, before being placed to light encouragement to complete the race. NACHO CORONA was steadied and taken outward, leaving the opening bend, to avoid contact with the rider less horse, maneuvered back to the inside soon afterwards, proceeded along the inside route until the quarter pole, angled outward and rallied well to secure the place. WARRANT OFC. COOK reserved along the outside for nearly six furlongs, swung four wide into the lane and had a good kick en route for the show. MACHO JOE forwardly placed, disputing the early pace, was apparently clipped from behind by FORE PALS soon after entering the backstretch, gradually maneuvered towards the middle of the course on the backstretch, to allow ample room for the now riderless rival to harmlessly scoot by, settled back into the two path to resume the chase once that foe was safely in front and well to the outside, issued his bid for the lead coming to the quarter pole, grabbed a narrow edge before coming under assault by the top one in upper stretch, failed to keep pace, yielding, then steadily weakened thereafter. PAGAN RULER outrun during the early stages, fanned wide into the stretch, settling into the five wide path at the top of the lane, failed to deliver the needed stretch response after being called upon. BACHHAUS vied for the lead along the inside, had a temporary interruption into that pace dispute when the loose rival arrived on the scene down the backstretch, allowed that foe to go by, with the rider attempting his best to remain motionless all the while, was joined up again by MACHO JOE at the half mile pole, raced on nearly even terms with that one until approaching the quarter pole before backing off. IDOL IMAGE was guided well out into the course to be out of harm's way, after the incident on the backstretch, entered the far turn from the four path before working his way into the two path by midpoint, was called upon during the stretch run, but had no rally. REIN KING three wide on the first turn, was through after a half. FORE PALS headstrong, resisting the snug hold being applied by the rider leaving the opening bend, advanced forward, eventually clipping the heels of MACHO JOE and unseating the rider as a result, There was a Stewards inquiry focusing on the incident on the

backstretch before the result was declared official.
