**Footnotes**

GANADOR was the first to pop out of the starting gate despite stumbling at the start, sparred from the inside during the initial stages, fell back slightly early on the turn, when kept to light hand encouragement, was taken off the rail in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, angled three wide into the stretch and was asked for a response, zeroed in on the front runner during the ensuing furlong, wrested away the lead a short distance past the eighth pole and drew clear, crossing the wire under a brisk hand ride. BIZARROWORLD contested for the lead three wide until the five-sixteenths pole, proved no match when the winner arrived on the scene by midstretch but continued on willingly enough to secure second. WILD PARTY was hand roused to secure a forward spot, vied for command from the two path until the five-sixteenths pole, was guided over to the inside, by this station no longer able to keep pace, weakened steadily thereafter. READYTODEFER chased three wide and lacked the necessary stretch response. JACKIN MY STYLE out hustled for the lead, ducked over to the rail midway on the turn, failed to reach contention. CAB'S HERE broke in a step, recovered and made a dash towards the inside, left the rail near the three-eighths pole, flip flopping spots with JACKIN MY STYLE, had little left to offer by the head of the stretch.
