Footnotes

STONECOLDSTEAMER broke alertly and soon established control, tucked along the rail and carved the pace, being rated along, edged away from the competition late on the turn and got set down spinning into the lane, kicked clear for good, driving. N. F.'S DESTINY broke out a step after lunging at the start, with the rider momentarily grabbing hold as a result, rode the rail down the backstretch but was in the two path by the half mile pole, kept gradually going wider during the run around the bend, being three wide at the five-sixteenths pole and yet wider still as the field headed into the stretch, finished well to earn the place although no match for the winner. BIG CITY BOY rode the rail from the beginning of the turn until its end, squeezed his way into the two path becoming the innermost member of a firing line of four giving chase on the top one at that juncture, got outfinished. MASTER SPLASH off the inside, was no factor. GREELEY'S LAW darted over to the inside after proceeding a few strides out of the starting gate, sat reserved under a firm hold by the pilot throughout the initial half, was maneuvered to be four wide making his way through the furlong grounds, mustered up a good enough kick to finish on even terms for the last major check. CYBERTRON departed the backstretch from the three path, ran around the turn with the rider leaning leftward and applying a solid grip on the left rein as well, lost position from the three-eighths pole onward as rivals got taken outward themselves until forced to take the five path for entrance into the stretch, flattened out in the final furlong. GINGER'S JOE saved ground for most of the way on the turn and tired. DR. COPPER pressed the issue from the two path in the opening stages before giving way.
