Footnotes

GALAXY JET away with no apparent incident at the start, secured a forward position, tracked the front runners taking the inside route, coaxed along to keep pace, paused in hand for a stride or so before angling outward coming to the quarter pole, settled into the two path for the commencement of the stretch run and took off in earnest, raced in tandem with the runner up leaving the eighth pole, wrested away the advantage from EXCLUSIVE SARAH about two jumps prior to the wire and gamely held it under a hand drive. GOING GOING GONE sat reserved in midpack in the two path, under the lightest of hand urging from the pilot to maintain interest, was moved outward turning for home until three wide by the three-sixteenths pole, hitched up to the eventual winner soon

afterwards, rallied in unison with that rival towards the front runners, albeit always a step behind, continued onward with gameness, missing out on win honors, still that same step behind. EXCLUSIVE SARAH patiently parked three wide off the pace fight for nearly a half, got released from a good hold from the rider in time for the stretch, forged her way to the front in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole but with top twosome closing in fast and looming major threats, got reeled in during the final yards and had to settle for the show. SAINT ANNA CARINA broke in slightly at the start but was pulled off the nearest opponent at the moment before any contact could be made, angled four wide starting from the five-sixteenths marker, needed more late to get the job done. PEGASUS DIAMOND bumped SWEETEST PEACH with good impact at the start, was forwardly placed along the inside early before flip flopping paths with BALL PERAZIM once that rival tucked along the inside the half mile pole, sparred two wide nearly evenly with the previously foe before edging away late on the turn, entered the stretch and responded well when called upon, felt heavy pressure coming to the furlong marker, dug in well enough to hold on to the lead for about another sixteenth, yielded and backed away. DARN THAT TRIP got away last after making solid contact with the right side of the starting gate, was under a good hold while remaining unhurried in the two path for almost a half, swung four wide into the stretch, had no rally. SHOPTILLCLOSING along the outside, was no factor. ROMOLO'S JULIET off the inside, was already under encouragement by the five-sixteenths pole, spun four wide into the lane and had no offering to render. BAAL PERAZIM dueled from along the rail on the turn and gave way. SWEETEST PEACH bumped at the start, saved ground throughout.
