WIN MCCOOL came away running, pressed the pace from the outside, responded when roused, drew clear and remained clear under a drive. GREAT INTENTIONS stumbled at the start, raced close up along the inside while in hand, rallied three wide approaching the stretch and finished gamely outside. STORMY KISS (ARG) raced in hand while three wide, swung wide entering the stretch and rallied outside. SWAP FLIPAROO was outrun early, came wide for the drive and was going well late outside. FOR ALL WE KNOW raced close up early along the inside, chased the pace and had no response when roused. INDIAN FLARE was unprepared for the start, broke in a tangle, was outrun early, raced wide on the turn and lacked a rally. EVER ELUSIVE was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused. PRETTY IMPOSING contested the pace along the inside and drifted out while tiring in the stretch.
