WHYDAH stalked outside for a half, rallied four wide at the quarter pole, surged to the front in midstretch and edged clear under left hand urging. LA CLOCHE was reserved for a half, rallied along the inside in upper stretch, drifted out under left hand whipping in midstretch and closed late while racing greenly. FAR ISLE pressed the pace between horses for a half and held well to gain a share. FLYINGLOUY was outrun for a half, advanced three wide in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. KEY QUALITY set the pace inside into upper stretch and tired. RED BARCHETTA raced just off the pace along the inside, angled out in upper stretch and lacked a late response. DO SO raced in midpack for five furlongs and tired. ELAROSE failed to mount a serious rally. ALBANY INDIAN was outrun after breaking slowly. I'M WITH YOU steadied along the inside at the half mile pole and was never close thereafter.
