## Footnotes

LAYSH LAYSH away in good order from the starting gate, was unhurried during the opening stages while racing the outside, began to pick up the pace departing the half mile pole, continued advancing into a good striking position after being lightly urged at the five-sixteenths pole, fanned four wide into the stretch, took off in earnest after being straightened away, wrested command in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and drew clear. WICKED CLIMB left the gate alertly, was the outermost member of a three way pace dispute down the backstretch, continued the pace battle during the run around the bend, shook free of the last original pace contender heading for the stretch, maintained a clear advantage with an eighth to go, after now having been set down, felt the top one's presence soon afterwards, offered resistance before surrendering near the sixteenth pole, but finished with good courage to earn the place. SAINT DAIMON perched three to four wide off the pace dispute, could only muster a mild bid en route for the show. GREEN BANANAS outrun for nearly a half, was asked for run at the five-sixteenths pole and improved position during the stretch run. AMERICAN CLASSIC vied for the lead until upper stretch and gave way. SAWTOOTH MOUNTAIN off a step slowly, was never involved. MISTER TRIESTER hustled early to a forward position, vied with a pair for the lead while racing along the inside, wilted after going a quarter.
