Footnotes

DUAL CITIZEN broke running to take charge, was quickly guided over to the inside, was rated on a loosely-contested lead while racing along the inside, spurted away from his closest pursuer during the run around the far turn, had the rider take a quick peek back coming to the quarter pole, lengthened away during the ensuing furlong, before finishing the race from there under primarily vigorous hand encouragement. FOR WES rode the rail, angled out for the stretch drive, and finished willingly for the place, although no match for the winner. MEDIEVAL SWORD took the inside route, angled out nearing the quarter pole, split rivals and showed good courage en route for the show. BROTHERS OUTLAW chased the pacesetter from the outside, was set down at the five-sixteenths pole and backed off. PIN bumped at the start, lacked the needed bid. MAXIMO STAR had no rally. WEE FREUDIAN knocked sideways shortly after the break, displayed some greenness during the opening stages, settled down soon after departing the elbow chute, was called upon in upper stretch and improved position by mainly weak and tired ones in the lane. CERVEZA DE BARRIL bumped at the start, was no factor. PEGASUS PAPOU never reached contention. KNOCK QUIETLY off the inside, was through after completing three-quarters. MARVOLO was bumped at the start and outrun. ROBBIE'S TURN forwardly placed three wide around the far turn, steadily tired after going five furlongs.
