## **Footnotes**

CHORUS MUSIC reserved between rivals for nearly three-quarters, found room to maneuver into the four path at the head of the stretch, responded positively when called upon, gained readily on the front runners during the run through the furlong grounds, took command a few strides past the eighth pole and edged clear under a hand drive. PRINCESS MAURA dueled along the inside for the lead, spurted away from that foe after turning for home, was put to the test by the top one nearing the eighth pole, offered brief resistance before yielding, but continued on with good courage to garner place honors. TRIPLE TAX EXEMPT outrun for almost six furlongs, swung wide into the lane, commenced to rally five wide at the top of the stretch and displayed a good kick down the outside of the course en route for the show. WHO IS LADY broke outward a bit at the start, was unhurried during the early going, remained on hold behind rivals turning for home, angled outward past the three-sixteenths pole for racing clearance and flashed interest under light encouragement. HIGH CRY chased three wide and folded. RAFFIE'S ROSE dueled from the outside and gave way. STARJETTA forwardly placed between rivals, faltered. KETUBAH saved ground to no avail. WILD AWAKE underwent a four wide journey and folded.
