UNBRIDLED OCEAN three wide departing the backstretch, was coaxed along, staying within striking distance behind a wall of rivals directly up ahead, in a very tightly-packed field, continued along the same scenario after entering the stretch, gained maneuverability leaving the eighth pole, availed of an opportunity to split rivals a sixteenth down the road, kicked in with good energy once safely through the hole, drawing caway to prove best. KANAGARO disputed the pace between rivals, edged away to a short advantage after completing the run through the furlong grounds, proved powerless to stave off the top one's challenge, but continued on gamely to garner place honors. LAST HURRAH underwent a pursuit while traversing the overland route and came home willingly to earn the show award. SIMBAMANGU wedged between rivals for well over a half mile, lacked the needed stretch response. AWED raced along the inside, argued for command with another pair, remained in the thick of things before weakening in the last eighth. GYRE put to encouragement leaving the starting gate, settled into midpack along the rail, took the inside route thereafter and came up empty for the stretch drive. POLIZIANO three wide, disputed the pace with another duo during the opening half before backing away. SANTO GATO pursued the front runners from the four path on the turn, folded.
