COUNT CATAMOUNT broke on top, was grabbed hold and took up the role of stalker, ranged up towards the leader leaving the five-sixteenths pole, turned for home and asked for a response, emerged from the furlong grounds the new leader, edged away kept under a drive. EVER A FRIEND unhurried in the two path for nearly a half, had a good finish near the inside to garner place honors. NORTHERN HAMMER tracked the pacesetter sitting in the pocket, vacated the premises during the stretch run, got out finished. DUKE OF NAPLES off to an alert start, quickly established control, cut the pace, well rated from the rail until the quarter pole, felt some real pressure for the first time at that juncture, yielded when unable to keep pace with the winner, and weakened steadily thereafter. I'VE GOT SPEED the early trailer, was asked to pick the pace midway on the turn, improved position belatedly by weak and tired ones. KING ROCK chased outside and had no rally. CHERNOBYL'S HERO settled into midpack soon after the start, stayed within range from the two path during the run around the bend, spun three wide for the stretch drive, had no offering to render. FISHERMAN'S WHARF rode the rail, squeezed into the two path just prior to the quarter pole, failed to fire when called upon. FUSA CODE coaxed along while saving ground, tired.
