Footnotes

HONEY TALK grabbed hold after breaking inward a couple of steps, assumed a forward position, initially stalked the front runners three wide, but was in the four path by midpoint, was put to urging nearing the quarter pole, entered the stretch and took off in earnest, was just shy of the lead with an eighth to go, battled heads apart with a very determined ASSATEAGUE from that station, getting a nose down in time to prove best. ASSATEAGUE moved up willingly towards the front making her way along the chute, pressed the issue just to the outside of INNER JOY, shadowed that opponent outward leaving the half mile pole, placed in the three path by the three-eighths pole, remained on hold until the three-sixteenths pole, quickly cleared ROCK ON HOME to take charge, but with the top one under a full drive in hot pursuit, raced on nearly terms until the wire, showcasing good determination to earn the place. SWEET ZAPPER reserved off the inside for six furlongs, commenced her stretch run five wide at the top of the lane, and had a good finish en route for the show. MORE THAN LOVE had a three wide journey and came home willingly. REMARKABLE MOON raced towards the back of the pack for the opening three-quarters, was angled outward gradually after entering the stretch, eventually placed in the six path by the three-sixteenths pole, showed a good kick

after completing the maneuver. CLOUD BANK sat well reserved along the outside, turned for home and was let out a notch, bobbled after making contact with EZPZ LEMON SQUEEZE in upper stretch, finished fairly evenly thereafter. BLUEGRASS SAPPHIRE chased from the outside, remained a prominent factor until midstretch before backing away. EZPZ LEMON SQUEEZE three wide, bumped with CLOUD BANK near the three-sixteenths pole, lacked the necessary stretch response. ROCK ON HOME settled into the pocket after the start and tracked the leader, came to the midway point on the turn with full passage along the inside, availed of the situation, wresting away the lead under light hand urging, felt the presence of a bevy of rivals heading for the lane and got called upon in response, gave in to the pressure before making it the furlong marker, and steadily tired. VERY SPECIAL LADY saved ground and was no factor. BLACK TRAIN fanned seven wide to the three-sixteenths pole, had no closing punch. INNER JOY cut the initial splits while saving ground, began to inch her way towards the two path departing the half mile pole, losing the lead to another as a result, fell back quickly soon afterwards.
