RUBY LIPS sat reserved from off the inside for the opening half, swung four wide into the stretch and kicked into gear, closed the gap readily after leaving the eighth pole, overhauled a pair of opponents prior to the wire, crossing the finish line under light hand encouragement. LAGUNA GIRL acted up enough to cause the rider bail out and re mount, proceeded to come away from the starting gate with no apparent mishap, was rated from between rivals while contesting the pace, got let out and kept pace with SAWYERS TRUSTYLADY while making her way through the furlong grounds, battled onward and drew on even terms about a sixteenth later, got collared by the winner a few jumps before the end but continued on gamely to garner the place. MERRY MEADOW three wide, was the outermost of a threesome vying for the lead, came home willingly once called upon for a stretch response, but had to settle for the show. SAWYERS TRUSTYLADY along the inside, argued to maintain a slim advantage with another pair parked out in lanes two and three respectively, responded well when given her cue at the head of the stretch, yielded then steadily fell back with about a sixteenth remaining. DOWAGER saved ground and lacked the necessary stretch response. SWITCHEROO along the rail, was rank while fighting against the bit early on the turn, was given some rein and went about more professionally during the later stages of the run around the bend, bided time approaching the quarter pole but angling out for the stretch run, made no headway on the front runners. THICKER THAN WATER raced along the outside and was outrun. WINNING SCOOP got off last after making light contact with the starting gate, darted over to the inside and stayed there for the rest of the way down the backstretch, appeared to climb just a bit while angling into the three path leaving the half mile pole, had no rally.
