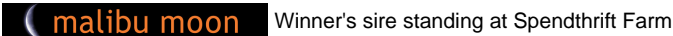

MOONSTOCK forwardly placed from the onset, set the pace inside well rated and accompanied, cut the corner into the stretch roused, edged away to the eighth pole, saw that margin cut into late on by a pair, repulsed their challenges under a drive to the wire. BARNARDS GALAXY leapt slightly at the break, settled just off the inside towards the rear, saved ground until shifting four to five wide at the head of the lane, commenced a drive at that juncture, kicked

home strongly albeit belatedly down the center of the course to procure the place honors in the last jumps. ZAJAL broke in at the start bumping SECTION A, was forwardly place three deep tracking the front from close range, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, rallied with good energy unable to reel in the top one, got outfinished in the last strides for the place honors while safely along for show. U WHIPPERSNAPPER placed in close attendance of the pace from just off the inside, got set down at the quarter pole, offered up a mild rally while getting out kicked in the latter portion of the stretch by the top trio. WAGON TRAIN four wide initially midpack, came under encouragement at the three-eighths pole while taking the overland route through the turn, cornered five wide for home, offered up a mild kick through the stretch while never threatening the top. PROMISED DESTINY two to three wide towards the rear, tried to get out entering the far turn, was given some off sided taps to correct the issue, swung four wide at the top of the lane, passed tired foes in the stretch. KOMISAREK broke in at the start bumping NORTHERN TRIPP, settled just off the inside in midpack, came under urging at the half mile pole, made some progress to the quarter pole, was placed to an all out drive at that station and offered little. WILDHAASSSEEE three wide midpack, came under coaxing at the midway point on the turn, spun four wide for home and weakened in the lane. NORTHERN TRIPP bumped at the start when KOMISAREK broke inwards, was rank under restraint early on stargazing into the backside run, settled once straightened to track from a close vicinity inside, got pushed along three furlongs from the finish and steadily gave way. SECRET SHIFTERS overland while towards the rear most of the way, was placed to prolonged urging from the seven-sixteenths and offered no response. SECTION A bumped at the start when ZAJAL broke in at the start, accompanied the pace three wide, came under a ride nearing the five-sixteenths and retreated. THUNDERVILLE saved ground while trailing throughout.
