KIBOSH assumed a forward position soon after the start, departed the backstretch from off the inside, was temporarily placed in the four path then proceeded to loop by another midway on the turn, re tucked into the three path once safely by and closed the gap from the front runners under some hand urging, turned for home and sustained the move, was the outermost of three arriving at the furlong marker simultaneously, shook free of them soon afterwards and edged away, kept to the task at hand. QUIET ENDING took the inside route, paused before angling out into the two path for the commencement of the stretch run, was gradually taken wider making her way through the furlong grounds, finished with good energy the last eighth to garner place honors. THESCREENISRED sparred with CATALINA ISLAND down the backstretch, tucked along the rail coming to the half mile pole, got displaced by the previously mentioned rival about a furlong later, went on a little further and was tipped into the two path, reached the eighth pole vying from between rivals for the lead, weakened into the show slot. CATALINA ISLAND disputed the pace from the outside, got loose from her early nemesis before completing the opening half and was sent over towards the inside, got hooked up a tussle once again in the stretch coming under intense pressure from two other rivals during the later stages of the run through the furlong grounds, succumbed to it and backed away. STRIKEALINETHRUIT swung five wide into upper stretch and had no impact. BARREL OF JOY three wide leaving the backstretch, lacked the needed response. AVE'S HALO put to early encouragement, rode the rail, entered the stretch, tired steadily advancing towards the finish line having been switched over to a light hand ride. COZY APP

chased the front runners from the two path and gave way. SCAT'S LASSIE between rivals on the turn, had no rally. SHOT GUN PENNIE three wide on the turn, folded. AKIRA off the inside, was five wide by the top of the lane and quickly tired.
