Footnotes

WAR HOOT stumbled at the start and was off slow as a result, saved ground towards the rear, came under encouragement nearing the quarter pole, swung three wide at that station, angled out one additional path nearing the eighth pole, displayed a good kick to get up at the wire and prevail under a drive. CAPTAIN WEBB three wide in midpack, came under a drive from three furlongs out, ranged up four wide to confront the leader at the quarter pole, overhauled the embattled pair nearing the final furlong, kicked home with good energy, got nailed on the wire and was forced to settle for place honors. WISHINGTONADREAM settled in midpack just off the inside, cut the corner roused into the stretch, kicked home with good energy inside to displace a trio and earn the show honors in the last few strides. DECIPHERING DREAMS set the pace from just off the inside in the two path while accompanied and under steadily intensified pressure as the field progressed, got set down with a trio in close pursuit at the head of the stretch, yielded the front nearing the

eighth pole, fought on stubbornly to the wire being outfinished in the last few strides while garnering the last major share. RED JACK attended the pace while two to three wide, was set down between foes at the head of the stretch, battled head to head for the lead through to just prior to the eighth pole when overhauled in tandem with his main pace foe, kept on digging in to the line but was out kicked in the last few strides for a major share. ELDER SKATESMAN towards the rear just off the inside while lightly coaxed along, came under further engagement by the rider approaching the quarter pole, swung five wide at that station, offered up a steady mild kick down the outside but just failed to make an impact. PUNSTER three wide towards the rear, came under a prolonged drive from the seven-sixteenths, swung four wide in upper stretch and passed tired rivals in the stretch. PARACHUTE CONEY raced two to three wide in midpack, came under a ride at the three-eighths and offered no response. PARKINSON FIELD three to four wide in close pursuit, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths and tired after turning for home. JOE VANN tracked inside, came under a drive at the three eighths and tired after a half.
