Footnotes

SUNNYBROOK broke alertly and needed only a few strides to take command, was guided over to the inside at the half mile pole, continued along the front, facing only mild pressure from the closest pursuer and with the rider still keeping something in reserve, entered the stretch with a comfortable advantage, responded positively once roused coming to the three-sixteenths pole, spurted away during the run through the furlong grounds, then increased the winning margin under strong handling to the wire. MISSISSIPPI TOO bumped with STRATEGIC SUE at the start, chased three wide around the turn, failed to keep pace with the eventual winner heading for the quarter pole, but finished willingly to be well clear of the others for the place. BY M K ducked to the rail coming to the half mile pole, made a mild move to improve position while on the turn, angled back outward nearing the quarter pole, splitting rivals entering the stretch, and was along in time for the show. MY TWO CENTS urged prompting the pacesetter from the outside, gave way after a half. STRATEGIC SUE bumped at the break, dropped back after being taken in hand, entered the turn from the three path, failed to reach a contending position at any time. SOLDIERETTE off a beat slowly, raced along the outside and was through after going three furlongs. FIGHTEN AWAY saved ground and faded after completing a half.
