Footnotes

TULANE UP contently brought up the back of the pack while racing along the outside, picked up interest during the later stages of the run around the turn, swung six wide into upper stretch, with the rider sitting chilly atop until the three-sixteenths pole, took off with a good burst of speed when finally asked for a response departing that station, quickly sped into contention during the ensuing sixteenth, maintained the momentum leaving the eighth pole, surging past the remaining front runners to complete the from last to first stretch run. CRYPTO KITTEN patiently tracked the front runners while riding along the rail, found enough room to angle outward just prior to the quarter pole, responded positively when given her cue, grabbed a short-lived lead in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, proved powerless to stave off the top one's charge, but held on willingly to secure second. NOTELL reserved off the inside, closed the gap during the initial portion of the stretch run, held well to grab the show. TROPICAL JETSET reserved in midpack along the outside for nearly three-quarters, got out finished. STRIKEALINETHRUIT unhurried for the opening half, moved into contention with a five wide run launched from the three-eighths pole, but could not sustain the bid after turning for home. SILVER MAST saved ground until the three-sixteenths pole, was only a light drive moving outward in a search for better racing room during the final furlong. REBELLIOUS CHIC bumped at the start, raced three wide along the chute working her way to the front, showed the way, under a good hold from the rider, with SARATOGA SILVER applying pressure along the outside, was let out entering the stretch, held her ground for the next furlong, got overhauled soon afterwards and tired. SARATOGA SILVER pressed the issue from the outside, was asked for

some run to keep pace by the five-sixteenths pole, folded. MOJITO MINT brushed after the start, had a wide trip and no kick. SUNNY SMILES raced along the outside and was through after completing three-quarters. LITTLE REYA came in, making contact with REBELLIOUS CHIC, underwent a three to four wide journey and tired. MY UNBRIDLED STORM bumped after the start, raced off the inside, was under a full drive just past three-eighths pole, retreated.
