RIGHT TO VOTE vied along the inside, began to edge away from the closest pursuer nearing the end of the turn, got put to encouragement, emerged from the furlong grounds holding a sizeable advantage, held safely, being kept busy to the end. SLEW hustled away leaving the starting gate, made it into midpack, was kept to mild hand urging proceeding from the outside on the bend, was guided into the four path by the five-sixteenths pole, in preparation for the stretch drive, finished with good energy down the lane, cut noticeably into the winner's margin late, but had to settle for place honors. DATTTTS HAPPY bobbed after ducking inward at the start, was under urging taking the inside route on the turn, proved no match for the top twosome. SUPERSTRUCTURE was hustled from the gate, contested the pace from the two path for nearly a half and gave way. RISE AGAINST was taken hold at the start, in reaction to outside pressure coming from DATTTTS HAPPY, was slow to settle, striding out greenly for most of the way down the backstretch, went more professionally upon reaching the turn, narrowed the gap during the ensuing quarter, moved outward slightly prior to splitting foes entering the stretch, altered course to the outside at the furlong marker, but had little left to offer. HOBBS reserved three wide for a half, came up empty. GOLD'N HOLIDAY trailed.
