Footnotes

STRUCTURAL CHANGE tracked the pacesetter from a distance while saving ground, was already under encouragement being angled off the rail at the quarter pole, gained readily making his way through the furlong grounds, grabbed the lead with about a sixteenth remaining and edged away. LUIGI P unhurried for the opening half, swung four wide into the lane, and closed strongly down the middle of the course to take second. FIJI STAR (ARG) raced along the outside and came home willingly to secure the show. OLD KIT BAG cut the corner into the stretch under urging, gained steadily on the front runners, altered course approaching the eighth pole for better racing room, finished fairly evenly thereafter. HE'S A SCROOGE gave chase from off the inside, picked up the pace under some encouragement nearing the end of the turn, sparrd on nearly even terms with TUDOR KING as the pair advanced towards the eighth pole, kept up the fight for a little while longer before flattening out. TUDOR KING broke running and made the front quickly, showed the way on an open lead while getting out down the backstretch and around the turn, faced a stiff challenge from a pair of rivals nearing the quarter pole, was in

the midst of the stretch battle when he came in sharply at the furlong marker, carrying RECHARGED towards the inside and placing that opponent precariously close to another's heels, began to weaken shortly afterwards. ZAAHY broke slowly, saved ground and failed to reach a contending position. RECHARGED three wide, was moving willingly, when impeded by TUDOR nearing midstretch, getting carried inward and forcing the pilot to check just behind HE'S A SCROOGE, failed to regain any interest thereafter. PIN three to four wide around the turn, was outrun. BOSTON POP raced along the outside, was asked for some run by the five-sixteenths pole, failed to respond. D J'S REVENGE appeared to lose his action soon after the start, was pulled up and subsequently vanned off. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the stretch run before the result was declared official.
