D' BULLDOG argued for the lead while racing near the inside, put away JUICY JACKLYN after being called upon at the quarter pole, was in possession of a comfortable lead with a furlong remaining, saw it dwindle down as a pair of pursuers closed in, reached the wire just in time to preserve the decision. CARDSONTABLEFACEUP chased from the outside, was put to a drive from the five-sixteenths pole, closed well, but missed. LEMON GHOST underwent a three wide pursuit, was put to a prolonged drive en route to taking third. JUICY JACKLYN contested the pace toward the two path for almost a half, got turned back, steadily tired thereafter and was vanned off after the finish. YESTERDAY'S STORY three wide at the three-eighths pole, folded. STORIESINTHEDARK faded off a ground-saving journey. CELLA MUFFLER spotted the field a lengthy head start, after rearing up at the break and slamming into the right side of the gate, always trailed. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the start of the race before the result was declared official.
