**Footnotes**

SEATTLE MISSION away well, quickly established control, set the pace, well rated along the inside for nearly three-quarters, got let out once the main stalker increased the pressure coming to the quarter pole, dug in with good determination as the front pair made their way towards the finish line to prove best. FORTISSI MORE assumed a forward position after the start, was initially rated while attending the pacesetter from the outside, was placed under some urging by the five-sixteenths pole prior to being called upon turning for home, battled hard and with game ness down the stretch but got denied. TAPITDAR settled along the inside after the start, rode the rail for the opening three-quarters pole, angled into the two path entering the stretch, bumped lightly with WARRIOR UP in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, continued onward, tipped one path wider with a sixteenth to go and held well enough to secure the show. MAJESTIC RAFFY three wide around both turns, fell back from midpack racing down the backstretch, picked up the pace from midpoint on the turn, then had a good finish down the center of the course to earn the last major slice of the pot. GAMBLIN FEVER took the inside route, launched a mild rail run to improve position. RUDY RUDY RUDY broke slowly, after slamming into the starting gate, moved up willingly under his own power to rejoin the pack, entered and departed the backstretch from the three path, was placed one path wider at the five-sixteenths pole, gearing up for the stretch run, spun into the lane from there under a drive, lacked the necessary response. FUGEDABOUDIT SANDY driven three wide into the stretch, flattened out. WARRIOR UP raced outside and tired. SARATOGA SQUIER had a three wide journey and folded. Following a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the start of the race, RUDY RUDY RUDY was declared a non starter, have been deemed so for having his tail stuck in the starting apparatus.
