Non-winners of a Grade 1 on the turf or a Grade 2 twice on the turf since May 1 allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade 2 on the turf, 5 lbs.; a Graded Sweepstakes, 7 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the Main Track. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee. Closed Saturday, September 3, 2011 with 23 Nominations.

WINTER MEMORIES was placed under a snug hold right after the start, pulled occasionally on the right side of the bit, but otherwise rated kindly, continued to race under the snug hold, wedged in amongst rivals, lost position approaching the quarter pole, entrapped behind a wall of rivals, bided time during the initial portion of the stretch drive, waited for HUNGRY ISLAND to go by, thus clearing passage to the outside and made her move, altered course outward in the vicinity of the furlong marker, got released from the previously described grip on the reins, and once placed to hand encouragement took off like a shot, powered by the pack to draw abreast of the leader, confidently went by in the final seventy yards, finishing the race under her own courage. THEYSKENS' THEORY bumped with KATHMANBLU a short distance from the starting gate, settled into midpack, was rated in the three path during the run around the second turn, got called upon spinning into the lane, fought her way to the front in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, proved no match when the winner arrived on the scene, but continued onward with good courage herself to be second best. MORE THAN REAL took the lead right from the start, was rated while setting the splits from the inside, got unleashed nearing the head of lane, showed good determination fending off all challengers during the ensuing furlong, before yielding reluctantly at the sixteenth pole. HUNGRY ISLAND three wide on the far turn, came from the five path into the lane, rallied mildly to earn the last major award. ARCH SUPPORT accompanied the pacesetter from the two path for three-quarters, had no rally. SALARY DRIVE saved ground throughout and lacked the needed response. PINCH PIE rated in the pocket, failed to fire when called upon. KATHMANBLU made light contact with the runner up soon after the start, took up a forward position soon afterwards, was rank offering fierce resistance against the bit while stalking the pacesetter, got asked for run as the field headed into the stretch, kept up her pursuit for an additional furlong before backing away.
