Footnotes

SHOW THE WAY J sprinted clear on the rail, shook loose in upper stretch and edged away under right hand urging. TIGER WILLIE raced well back behind horses on the turn, swung out and rallied belatedly. FRESHMAN DORM raced well back for a half, swung three wide and closed late in the middle of the track. PETELOVESHISBOOTS saved ground just off the pace into upper stretch and lacked a late response. ALWAYS MINE pressed the winner from outside on the turn and steadily tired thereafter. J'BOY raced in hand early, split horses on the turn and lacked a late response. UNIQUE TUNE checked in tight at the start, steadied along the rail at the three-eighths pole and failed to threaten thereafter. FREIGHT FORWARD made a run four wide to reach contention at the quarter pole and flattened out. HAMMERING BUCKEYE steadied between horses at the three-eighths pole and gave way. LOYAL LEADER took up after breaking slowly and was never close thereafter.
