GLOBAL FORCE broke in sharply but was pulled off GALLANT FIELDS in time to avoid contact, went on to establish command under his own power, set the pace slightly off the inside and with the rider applying rating tactics, sat chilly on the turn as the field zeroed in, responded positively when given his cue just past the quarter pole, lengthened out to a comfortable advantage during the ensuing furlong, then successfully staved off the lone stretch threat being kept busy to the end. DAY OF DESTINY rode the rail tracking the pacesetter under a good hold, steadied slightly while in a tight coming to the quarter pole, failed to match the top one's display of energy, angled outward at the eighth pole, gained readily thereafter but had to settle for place honors. CRAVIN CADEN a bit slow to settle into stride, advanced on his own courage from midpoint on the backstretch, split rivals at the half mile pole to continue the bid, was guided over into the four path, resumed the march forward, got to nearly the leader's hind quarters but could make no additional progress. TWO BRASH forwardly placed along the outside, tired after going three-quarters. WORTH A BUCK took the overland route around the turn to no avail. GALLANT FIELDS reserved early, was coaxed along approaching the end of the run down the backstretch, but lost ground nonetheless, drifted wide into the lane while lacking any solid stretch offering. PISCITELLI left the gate awkwardly, accompanied the leader in hand from the outside for a half and gave way.
