Footnotes

BANNED within striking distance three wide around both turns, advanced toward the pacesetter coming to the head of the stretch, continued to narrow in on that rival, while still kept in reserve, was given his cue coming to the three-sixteenths pole, poked a head in front at the eighth pole, then drew away under good handling. UNCLE JOE under a snug hold and wide around the opening bend, took charge soon after entering the backstretch, was rated on the front, well off the inside, inched closer to the inside once he reached the far turn, felt pressure for the initial time nearing the quarter pole, saw the lead continue to evaporate, despite having now been asked for run, succumbed with an eighth to go, but continued onward well to preserve the place. BRILLIANT SPEED between rivals on the second turn, came home willingly en route for the show. LEGEND OF NAVARONE loosely drafted behind BRILLIANT SPEED on the far turn, while well in hand, angled three wide under encouragement turning for home, but failed to muster up a strong kick. DAX saved ground, slipped outward late on the far turn, flattened out leaving the furlong grounds. REVELATOR strung out five wide around the far turn, improved position by mainly weak and tired ones. TIZ TO BE saved ground and was no factor. MAGNET COVE forwardly placed towards the inside for three-quarters, gave way. LE DOCTEUR PLUNKET four wide on the second bend, folded. FLY ON THE WALL reluctant to load, flipped off the rider during the first attempt to get him into the starting gate, proceeded to come out in good order, underwent a three to four wide journey and tired.
