SINGN ON THEMOON settled well while in reserve along the rail, controlled a mild tempo throughout, was lightly urged midway on the far turn, came under a strong drive at the top of the lane and held well to the end. FASHION'S FLIGHT three wide throughout under a snug hold, came under a drive at the head of the stretch gaining steadily on the leader to earn the place. RICHBELLE brushed the right side of the gate at the start, tracked the leader just off the inside, vied between rivals on the far turn, came under a drive approaching the top of the lane offering a mild kick for show honors. MCCARREN PARK trailed early while in hand, swung four wide at the top of the lane but lacked any late response, passing only a tiring rival. CLUAIN MEALA saved ground throughout ,came under urging midway on the turn and steadily tired.
