CABRITA POINT contested the pace from the outside, dug in gamely in the stretch and prevailed under a drive. PENNANT PUNCH, close up inside, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely. TOUCH SILVER raced wide and stayed on well. REPARATIONS raced wide and finished with good courage outside. HEAVEN ON SEVEN contested the pace along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. PRINCE OF RUCKUS ducked in after the start, chased inside, dropped back, raced wide and lacked a rally. SHOOT THE WORKS had no rally. JIMMIES was outrun.
