MY GIRL NESSA showed speed along the inside, enjoyed a clear trip on the rail, drew away turning for home and remained safely clear under a drive. IRISH RAIL raced wide and rallied to get the place prize. LADY NELSON was outrun early and was going well late outside. GOLD OXIDE raced four wide and lacked a rally. DEAD OF WINTER raced inside and had no rally. MY GIRL NATALIE raced wide throughout and had no rally. NOVEMBER ROSE set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. PERSEID raced wide and had no rally. WATT EVER showed speed while between rivals and tired after a half mile. CONTROL tired after showing brief speed. RAQUEL was outrun. KNIGHTLY SIGNAL raced very wide throughout and tired.
