Footnotes

MEEKER AVENUE hooked up in a duel with CAN'T CATCH ME NOW soon after the start, was always the more energetically-handled of the two during the run around the bend, being asked for more and more from the three-eighths pole onward until turning for home under a drive, positioned closer to the two path than on the rail at this point, repulsed the previously mentioned rival even after that foe was himself called upon for the initial time in upper stretch, edged away, kept to the task at hand. SMOOTH BERT off the inside, was three wide and roused by the five-sixteenths pole, tipped wider yet during the initial portion of the stretch run, displayed enough energy to get up for the place. CAN'T CATCH ME NOW rated near the two path while contesting the pace for much of the opening half, got called upon past the quarter pole and got outfinished. GULLTOPPER raced along the outside and lacked the necessary stretch response. RETIRED got off slowly, pulled greenly on the left side of the bit proceeding down the backstretch, picked up interest approaching the quarter pole while starting to swing three wide, paused off rivals then was sharply taken another couple of lanes in the direction of the middle of the strip, finished well enough thereafter to be in front of half the field by the end. ONE SMOKIN CAT was guided over to the rail before reaching the end of the backstretch, was already under encouragement cutting the corner into the stretch, failed to have an impact. THINGAMAJIGGER placed five wide at the head of the stretch, had no rally. CHRISANDLORISPOSSE put to hustling tactics leaving the starting gate, had it interrupted when forced to be taken in hand after getting carried in slightly and shying away from an errant HARSH, rode the rail and was outrun thereafter. HARSH bobbed after coming inward at

the start, went on to save ground to no avail. NOOSH'S TALE four wide departing the backstretch, was along the rail entering the stretch, gave way. ZEDDEMORE vied from between rivals in the initial stages, tired after going a half. GOODTOLOOK forwardly placed three wide, was pulled up nearing the quarter pole and vanned off.
