STAYING ON (IRE) sat reserved for nearly two miles, picked up the pace upon reach the fourth turn, responded positively when asked for a entering the stretch, arrived at the penultimate jump first, albeit by a slim margin, hooked up in a duel with the runner up in the final furlong and gamely proved best. POWEROFONE within range from off the inside, advanced into a stronger contending position heading for the top of the stretch the last time, engaged in a spirited tussle with the winner during the last eighth and got denied. SHARP NUMBERS checked and bumped by a loose horse after the third jump, raced three wide on the last two turns, got set down for the drive home and rallied for the show. CAT FEATHERS taken in hand in reaction to the fallen foe at the second hurdle, underwent a ground-saving journey, made an abbreviated bid heading for the top of the lane, flattened out. EXTRAEXTRAORDINARY mostly inside, was taken in hand reacting to incident during the initial stages, was taken in hand a second time at the ninth jump, lacked the needed response. MARTINI BROTHER strung out three wide on the first turn, checked at the third jump, had no rally. BODIE ISLAND forwardly placed while racing three wide around each and every turn, fell back steadily after departing the backstretch for the final time, left the course coming to the final hurdle. SULWAAN (IRE) rated kindly along the inside on a loosely-contested lead, took a bad step after making it over the eighth hurdle, was pulled up and subsequently vanned off. COGNASHENE the early leader, veered in sharply coming to the fourth jump, made solid contact with it and lost the rider. SKIP stumbled when landing at the third hurdle losing the rider in the process.
