Footnotes

DUAL CITIZEN well rated just off the pace placed in the three path, remained under a light hold when assuming command nearing the quarter pole under his own power, got roused straightening for home, edged away with a furlong remaining to a safe lead, saw that margin cut into a bit late on while safely prevailing kept to task to the line. BIG SKY POSSE unhurried two or three wide towards the rear, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, swung out six wide at the head of the stretch, kicked home belatedly for the place cutting into the winner's lead in the late stages. CAFE DES ARTISTES just off the pace four wide throughout, came under a drive at the quarter pole, kicked home with good energy unable to reel in the top one while getting out kicked in the final sixteenth and safely garnering the show. ALCOMATCH scraped the paint towards the rear unhurried until the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the lane, offered up a mild bid for the last major share. MR. VANTASTIC well off the inside towards the rear, came under coaxing at the three-eighths pole, swung five wide for home and offered no kick. FOOLISH TIGER three to four wide towards the rear, came under a ride at the three-eighths pole, spun four wide in upper stretch and gave no response. WORTH A BUCK settled midpack just off the inside, came under a spirited ride at the five-sixteenths, cornered three wide for home and tired. SLAMM'N LOU between foes midpack, came under a prolonged urging from the half mile pole, retreated steadily and tired.

ALLTIFEDOFF set the pace from just off the inside while attended but not under any direct pressure, came under urging at the three-eighths pole, conceded the front nearing the quarter pole and gave way.
