BIG BUSINESS bobbled slightly at the break, settled towards the rear just off the inside, steadily progressed on the front under very little encouragement, waited briefly in behind the pace at the head of the stretch, angled out nearing the eighth pole for a clear lane commencing a drive, confronted the lone leader a sixteenth from home with good kick all out, fought head to head with that foe through to the line, got up in the final strides in a game effort. BLACK RHINO broke out at the start bumping lightly with TROUBLE IN DODGE, before being corrected, prompted the pace while two to three wide under a light hold, was placed to a drive at the three-sixteenths, took over the front nearing the furlong grounds, got confronted a sixteenth down the road, fought head to head through to the wire, got nailed in the last jumps and forced to settle for the place in a good effort. TROUBLE IN DODGE chased the front while four to five wide throughout under urging from the seven-sixteenths, offered up a mild kick through the lane to be along for show honors. DECISIVE MOVE set a pressured pace along the inside under very light coaxing only until roused at the three-sixteenths, yielded the lead steps before the eighth pole, kept on for a further sixteenth before weakening in the late stages while safely procuring the last major share. LOST DECADE just off the pace four wide through the turn, came under urging at the midway point, shifted five to six wide in upper stretch, rallied mildly by tired foes in the lane. DEVOTED WILDCAT settled in close pursuit from the one and one, came under a ride nearing the five-sixteenths, spun three wide for home and weakened in the stretch. TIGHTEND

TOUCHDOWN lightly jostled at the start between foes, tracked along the inside, cut the corner under encouragement, offered no response. SHOTINTHEFOG stumbled slightly at the start, chased inside from the rear while outrun in the early stages and never factored. PERFECT TRIPPI saved ground towards the rear, was put to urging at the three-eighths pole, offered no kick and was not persevered with in the final eighth.
