Footnotes

STAR CHANNEL broke on top, was kept to a firm hold by the pilot and allowed to drop back into the middle of the field while making his way towards the end of the homestretch, sat well reserved in the two path down the backstretch and during the opening phase of the run around the far turn, got tipped into the four path coming to the five-sixteenths pole, and after being given his cue, mustered up a solid burst of speed to loom boldly as the widest of four front runners in close proximity from front to back spinning into the stretch, chiseled away at the leader's advantage, forged ahead to take over in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, kicked clear. NORTH SLOPE settled in midpack, got eased into the three path about midway down the backstretch, took the same lane travelling around the second bend, got set down to a drive a couple of jumps prior to the quarter pole, challenged in earnest from between rivals turning for home, fought his way to a slim lead by the eighth pole, got reeled in a sixteenth down the road, held on in a willing manner for the place. ARC ABOVE prompted the pace from the two path, under patient handling until a short distance from the quarter pole, was under a drive issuing a challenge from between opponents at that station, wasn't up to the task at hand and tired. TIZ GIANNI rode the rail for nearly a mile, was taken outward, commenced the stretch from the four path, had no rally. CANAVERAL (GB) raced along the outside to the five-sixteenths pole, was under solid encouragement cutting the corner into the stretch, lacked the needed response. SHARE OUT saved ground until near the five-sixteenths pole, was sharply angled three wide into the stretch, made no headway. OVERWHELMING established control shortly after the start, pilot atop with a firm hold, and was guided over to the rail, cut the pace, well rated, came under intensified pressure coming to the quarter pole and got roused in response to the three rivals in hot pursuit parked to his outside, succumbed readily and gave way.
