BONAPAW took charge from the start, set the pace while well in hand, responded when shaken up in midstretch, drew clear and was kept to the task to the wire. ALDEBARAN was outrun early, raced three wide and finished gamely outside. VOODOO was steadied while with the pace on the backstretch, moved up outside to press the pace, could not handle the winner in the stretch and faded in the final furlong. MULTIPLE CHOICE raced close up inside early, was eased back and put in a three wide run approaching the stretch then tired in the drive. WILD SUMMER was outrun early, raced inside and had no rally. GRIFFINITE dropped back early, raced wide and had no response when roused.
