JUROR broke awkwardly, was steadied after the start, rallied four wide approaching the stretch and drew clear late. ADMIRAL BIRD ducked out at the start, was steadied, rallied three wide and stayed on gamely for the place. MOON ALA MODE was hustled out to a clear lead, set the pace along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. FALSE I. D. was outrun early, came wide for the drive and finished well outside. OF ALL TIMES chased the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. GOOD GOING DARL raced close up inside, saved ground and raced in traffic along the inside in the stretch. MY MAN LARS had no rally. IRVING'S DOERS raced inside and tired. QUESTIONING raced wide throughout and tired.
