**Footnotes**

STANFORD DOLLY was well off the inside throughout, left the half mile pole four wide, the five-sixteenths pole, five wide and being asked for some kind of response for the initial time, before taken into the stretch from the six path, got placed to a hard drive after being straightened away, closed in readily during the next furlong, collared the leader leaving the sixteenth pole and edged away in the final seventy yards. FAR ISLE sat perched from the four path right off

a disputed pace, ranged up towards the embattled front runners late on the turn and issued a challenge in earnest entering the stretch, fought her way to the slimmest of leads by the furlong marker, dug in stubbornly before relinquishing to the winner in the late stages, continued onward with good courage to secure second. KAISER'S D'LIGHT sat reserved between rivals during the run around the turn, found enough space to squeeze into the four path just before spinning into the lane, responded positively when given her cue, hesitated for just a stride coming up to the heels of several others in the vicinity of the eighth pole, resumed her stretch run and got up to win the photo for third. IN HER HEY DAY was put to some encouragement to secure a forward spot, took the inside route, within range of the ongoing pace fight, was called upon and launched a rail run, looming for just a moment a threat with an eighth remaining, soon flattened out, getting nipped for show honors. GRACE AND COURAGE three wide, disputed the pace the widest of a threesome, kept up the fight before weakening in the final furlong. FOREVER GRATEFUL broke alertly and was taken to the inside, argued for command with another pair until the quarter pole. KARAKÖRUM FUGITIVE slammed into the left side of the starting gate, was taken hold to avoid making contact with rivals on each side, raced along the outside thereafter and was no threat. AMIRAHY swung seven wide into upper stretch, had no rally. APRILMAYJUNE three wide around the turn, tired. MORE IS BETTER three wide entering the turn, was in the seven path departing it, failed to menace. KISSDON'T TELL pulled off a foe at the start, was always outrun. LONG GONE vied between rivals for the opening half, retreated.
