Footnotes

EA raced in midpack from off the inside, swung three wide into the stretch and got set down, make some progress on the leader during the initial portion of the stretch run but more so once past the eighth pole, drew even with LISTON in the vicinity of the sixteenth marker, took over soon afterwards and edged away. LISTON vied to maintain a slim advantage while kept at a slight distance from off the inside, shook off the chief nemesis at the time, this being DREAMING BLUE, just before completing three-quarters, then got asked for a response entering the stretch, held on well until about a sixteenth remaining, relinquished to the winner but dug in well enough long enough to preserve the place. IRISH LION unhurried early, was already under encouragement turning for home four wide, closed in with good late energy en route for the show. DREAMING BLUE disputed the pace from the outside for the opening three-quarters before backing away. SKY MUSIC fanned five wide into the stretch, had no rally. CINNAMON BEACH under a prolonged drive, was put into the three path midpoint on the turn, folded. PERFECT FOOTPRINT faded off a ground-saving journey.
