BARREL OF LOVE was firmly rated for the opening half, left the midway point on the turn three wide and swung a bit wider yet into the stretch, went onward slightly more before finally got asked for a response, displayed a good kick to wrest away the lead in the final seventy yards, then edged away. HEAR THE FOOTSTEPS patiently stalked the front runners from the outside, was placed three wide during the early stages of the stretch run, closed in well with good late foot to procure the place. KARAKORUM LEGEND rated along the inside early, vied to maintain a narrow advantage, while pressed by VICTORIOUS LEADER around the turn, was set down for the drive home as the pressure intensified, held his ground well before yielding past the sixteenth pole. VICTORIOUS LEADER assumed a forward position early down the backstretch, prompted the leader from the outside, got asked for a response and gave it for the stretch run, kept up the fight until the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, drifted out slightly while weakening at this stage, settling at the end for the last major slice of the pot. SKY BLUE PINK bumped lightly with FOURSEVENTEEN shortly after leaving the starting gate, got grabbed hold and guided over to the rail, remained there proceeding the backstretch, chose the two path for the run around the bend however, entered the stretch and got called upon, found himself rallying between rivals in midstretch doing so with ample room separating him from the other two, was still moving well when forced to check off VICTORIOUS LEADER'S heels after that one had inadvertently drifted into his lane coming to the sixteenth pole, was taken a couple of paths attempting to secure optimal racing clearance once again, achieved the goal, but with little time left to pick up any real interest. GIMME CREDIT rode the rail in the early

going, was eased slightly outward coming to the half mile pole seeking to take up position in the two path at this juncture, went on for another furlong, saw the mission turning out to be futile and re tucked along the rail, stayed there for the rest of the way biding time, found enough space turning for home and slithered into the two path at last at the top of the lane, remained prominently spotted all through the going through the furlong grounds then flattened out. FOURSEVENTEEN made light contact with SKY BLUE PINK just out of the starting gate, was sent over towards the inside took up residence in the two path, was well reserved from there, pilot atop with a firm grip on the reins while proceeding down the backstretch, got taken outward late on the turn until placed four wide by the head of the stretch, failed to muster up a solid closing response. ISN'TLOVEJUSTGRAND saved ground to no avail. DRIVEN BY SOLAR underwent a three wide pursuit, was let out by the five-sixteenths pole, folded.
