MR. STYLE chased the pacesetter from the three path, launched a successful challenge to take over turning for home, scampered away to his biggest advantage during the ensuing furlong, drifted out, especially in the final furlong, with LUCCI THE LION willingly or not following suit, was kept going under solid encouragement to hold on safely. ROMAN'S AVENUE bumped at the start, was taken in hand getting gently squeezed back, raced off the inside under the backstretch, but settled at a slight distance from off it by the half mile pole, was given his cue and got angled outward approaching the five-sixteenths marker, mustered up some belated energy to procure the place, while never posing a threat to his barn mate. LUCCI THE LION underwent a four wide pursuit, got asked for a response for the stretch, appeared to be herded out by the winner during much of the final furlong, while getting outfinished by each of the top twosome. KELTIC FIGHTER raced along the outside, launched a mild run from upper to midstretch attempting to rally into contention, flattened out. DAN THE IRISHMAN bumped from between rivals at the start, saved ground until the quarter pole, swung six wide, the widest of all into the stretch, made no headway. EVERYDOGHASHISDAY gave chase three wide and was outrun. THE SIXTIES (GB) bumped at the start, tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, faltered. DERBY WATCH bumped at the start, went on to take command, cut the pace from the two path, got displaced coming to the end of the bend and gave way. KING HENNY bobbed at the break, departed the backstretch from the three path, was done after a half, then was pulled up very quickly after making it across the finish line.
