KINGSFORD DRIVE took charge shortly after the start, was kept at a slight distance from of the rail while being rated on a loosely-contested lead, drew off placed to a light drive after completing the opening half. TUMMEL tracked the winner from the pocket, cut the corner, proved no match for that rival while holding on well enough to take the place. POINT TAKEN reserved in the two path within range, pilot atop with a firm grip on the reins, was put to solid encouragement coming into the stretch, missed out on the place. QUICK MONEY saved ground and failed to menace. FRAZIL underwent a four wide pursuit on the turn, tired. HAVERHILL three wide at the top of the turn, commenced the stretch being five to six wide, had no late response. BEER IS GOOD chased the winner along the two path and gave way. THINKING OF GIRLS three wide departing the backstretch, was outrun. METAURUS off a beat slowly, was strung out in the four path on turn, folded.
