FICKLE FRIENDS contested the pace along the inside and stayed on gamely to the finish. HIT THE BOARD, hustled along early, raced wide and finished with good courage. CROWN AND WATER, outrun early, came wide for the drive and finished well. REFLECT THE MUSIC broke awkwardly and lacked a rally. FOREVER CINDY raced inside and had no rally. NUMARA contested the pace while three wide and tired in the stretch. KALIDASA contested the pace while between rivals and tired after three quarters. SWISS COUNTRY had no response when roused. RUN ALEXIS RUN tired after a wide trip.
