CHASING LIGHTNING reserved within striking distance while three wide, rallied when ready on the turn, collared the pacesetter by the top of the stretch, held a clear advantage at the furlong grounds and drew off under a drive. CRACK THE BOOKS pressed the pace outside, won the battle for the place. I WILL SURVIVE along the rail, was hounded while setting the early fractions, weakened in the final stages. VICTORY GULCH came wide in the stretch, lacked the necessary rally. OUTTA LUCK broke awkwardly, had no rally. MIKAYLA'S PROSPECT had no response when roused. LIVEITUPNOW displayed brief speed and gave way. TOPSPIN LOB underwent a wide trip, tired. DRINK TIL HE HOWLS was outrun. SPLENDID ROSE (GB) tired badly and was eased in the stretch.
