ANY LIMIT stumbled at the start, set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. NOTRE DAME (BRZ) raced inside and had no response when roused. EXPLOIVACIOUS stumbled at the start and had no rally. LILA PAIGE was outrun along the inside.
